Eligibility and Fees

The eligibility for membership of the Company (ACWA) as outlined in the Constitution is provided below.

Eligibility

A not-for-profit organisation that provides child, youth and family welfare services in NSW or the ACT and who supports the purposes of the company. (Note 'member' refers only to an incorporated body).

Important Things to Know

- As a member organisation, you must nominate a contact person as delegate. We suggest that this person is the CEO or Director. The delegate is the only person who can endorse the nomination of a candidate for the Board of ACWA. In addition, the delegate is the only person who can vote on behalf of the organisation and/or stand as a candidate for election to the Board of ACWA.
- It is the responsibility of the member to advise ACWA of any changes to their contact details, including those of the contact person.

Membership Fee

The membership fee for organisations that apply for membership is based on the child, youth and family services revenue of the organisation for the previous financial year.

Example A:

A large not-for-profit had an annual turnover of \$54 million for 2018-19. Of that amount, \$36 million is utilised for child, youth and family services. This agency's membership fee for 2020 is \$7018.

Example B:

A small not-for-profit agency had an annual turnover of \$2.4 million for 2018-19. Of that amount, \$2.3 million is utilised for child, youth and family services. This agency's membership fee for 2020 is \$280.

Up to \$3M	\$280
Over \$3M, up to \$5M	\$709
Over \$5M, up to \$10M	\$2112
Over \$10M, up to \$25M	\$3518
Over \$25M	\$7018

* Membership fees are due on 1 January annually.

* Fee amounts are inclusive of GST

* Pro Rata fees apply for organisations joining throughout the year.
